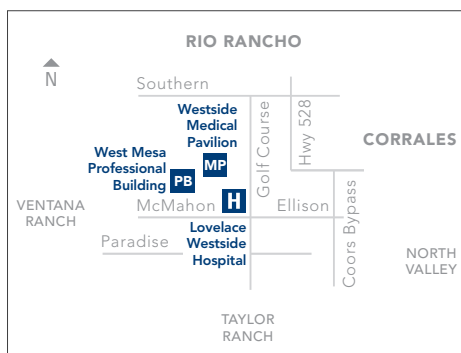
Facts About Lovelace Health System
